<b>9</b>	Last day to submit a request for payment of Presidential Nomination Primary expenses to the OSS. Must include an itemized description of actual costs & copies of invoices & must be certified. The OSS shall provide each municipality with the appropriate forms for requesting payment & certifying expenses for the Presidential Nomination Primary - within 60 days after the presidential nomination primary state canvass board meeting. M.S. 207A.15, subd. 2(b)
<b>14</b>	County auditor begins period of redemption for all parcels against which judgment has been entered for delinquent real estate property taxes and judgment remains unsatisfied. MS § 280.01.
<b>15</b>	Noxious weed inspections should begin in southern part of state. Final date for the publication of a general weed notice for the county that is to be posted by the County Agricultural Inspector. MS § 18.83.
<b>20</b>	County Treasurer makes full settlement with the County Auditor of all taxes collected since date of last settlement. MS § 276.09. Within 60 days after the settlement, County Treasurer shall pay the balance of amounts collected to towns. MS § 276.11

## 2020 MAT Scholarship Deadline is May 1

The Minnesota Association of Townships Scholarship Program awards up to FIVE \$2,000 scholarships each year. All students currently enrolled in the 11th grade and attending a Minnesota public, private, or parochial high school or a home-study program are eligible for this program. Winners will be chosen based on a written essay. All applications for the awards must be submitted by May 1st of each year; winners announced by October.

Along with the completed application and written essay, high school juniors of any public, private or home-schooled students must submit:

- A current high school transcript
- A letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or counselor
- All items must be submitted in one envelope and mailed to: Minnesota Association of Townships Scholarship Program, P.O. Box 267, St. Michael, MN 55376, postmarked by May 1, each year. Incomplete applications or applications postmarked after May 1 will not be accepted.

Winners will be notified in writing by mid-October and will be invited to attend the MAT Annual Meeting to be held each November. Scholarship awards will be paid to the appropriate financial aid office upon completion of proper paperwork provided by the college, university, or technical school.

Each year, a new scholarship question is released in December and letters will be mailed to high schools statewide along with home-school publications we know about. Anyone can visit our website at [www.mntownships.org](http://www.mntownships.org) and download the application as well.
