(Board must meet after the second Friday in June on at least one meeting day and may meet for up to ten consecutive meeting days.) MS § 274.14.
20	County distributes 70% of estimated collections of personal property taxes and first half real property taxes to township (within 30 days of May 20). MS § 276.11.
24	State Demographers must receive challenges to the 2020 population and household estimates no later than this date. MS § 4A.02 (c).
25	First day to mail ballot precincts for Primary (no more than 46 days, nor later than 14 days prior to Primary election). MS § 204B.45. sub 2.
30	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All State Auditor forms due from volunteer fire relief associations with assets or liabilities of at least \$500,000. MS § 69.051, subd. 1.• Last day for State, County or Special Boards of Appeal & Equalization to meet. MS §§ 270.12; 274.14.• Last day for Commissioner of Revenue to certify changes in assessments as revised by State Board of Appeal & Equalization to county auditors unless Abstract was late. MS § 270C.91.• Town Financial Reporting form due to State Auditor (in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) and GAAP Basis of Accounting) available early February and due June 30 (March 31 date is for cash basis accounting).• Municipal Construction and Development Fee Revenue and Expense Annual Report by June 30. MS § 326B.145.
